

# SimBegin

- A faculty development course designed for new simulation educators



**SimBegin is a course designed by the SAFER simulation centre for beginners in simulation and debriefing. It is a hybrid course with e-learning, online workshops and a face-to-face workshops. The workshops involves participants of the course working in small groups to increase interaction with faculty and learning.**

## SimBegin course content

### Module 1 - E-learning

Introduction to medical simulation, circle of learning and facilitation.  
Estimated time: 2-3 hours

### Module 2 - Online workshops

Understanding how to deliver high-quality and structured pre-briefing, high-quality and structured CORE-debriefing- e-learning and 3 online workshops.  
Duration: 3 workshops with duration of 2-3 hours

### Module 3 - Face-to-face workshops

Implementation of multiple scenarios, pre-briefings and debriefings, post reflection on enhancing best simulation practice at a simulation centre.  
Duration: 1 full training day

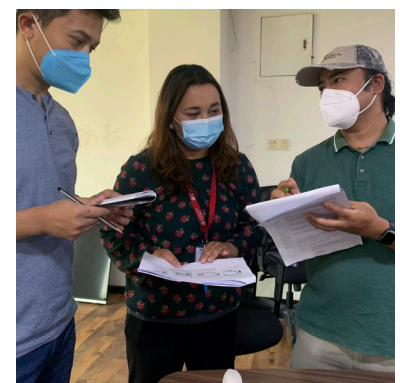


## Who should take the course SimBegin?
